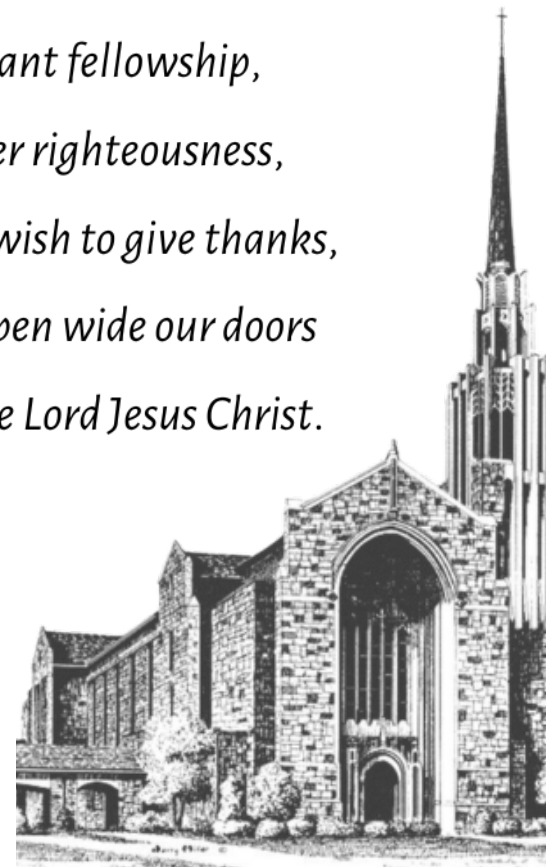
WELCOME

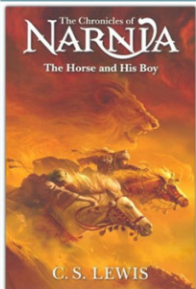

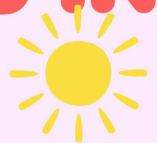
