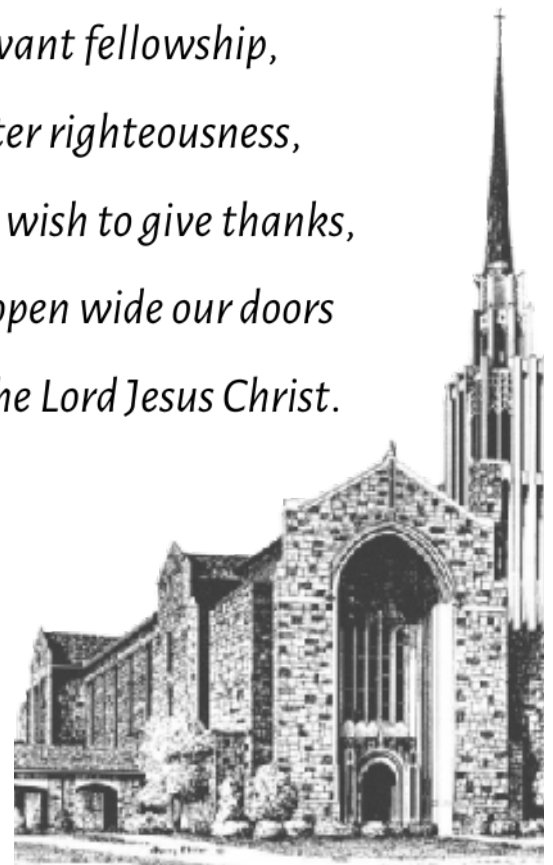
WELCOME
