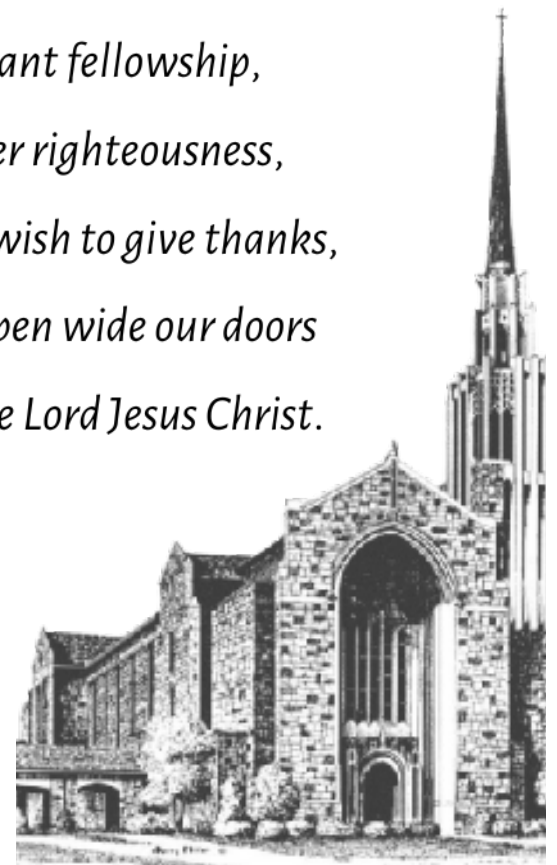
WELCOME
