3. When Jesus challenged the crowd's understanding and expectations of Good News, he was rejected. As you take time for honest reflection, have there been times in your life when your understanding and expectations of faith and Christ have been challenged or not in alignment with the Good News? How have you navigated or grown through these experiences?


Next Sunday, February 2nd will be our next collection with the collection going to Macedonia. Bins will be placed outside of all three services for your deposits.
