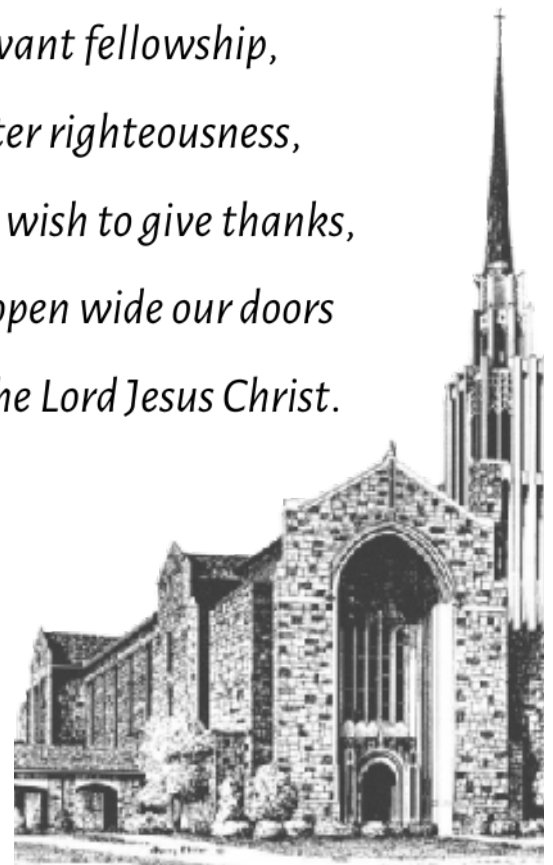
WELCOME
