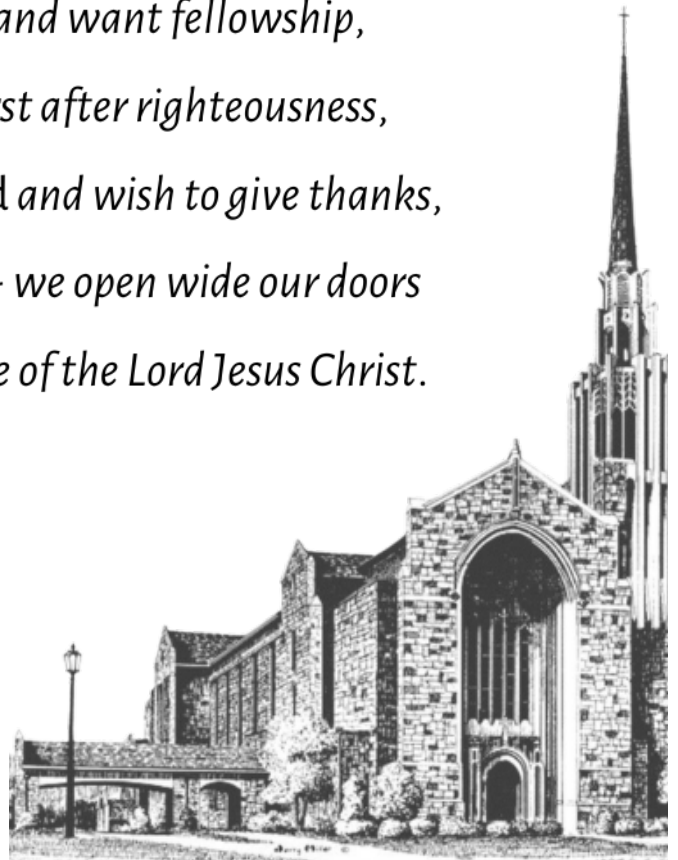
To all who are spiritually weary *and seek rest*,

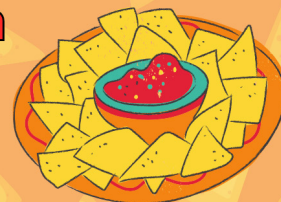
