Mission Moment

Open Door Ministries continues to provide critical services for men in our community without resources for food or housing. During the winter months, the shelter has operated at full capacity with 60 +/- on the waiting list. During the periods of extreme cold in December and January they managed to provide life-saving accommodations for an additional 15-20 men per night. There are plans to open a new Day Center which will allow ODM to offer more AA/NA services, laundry facilities, and a nurse/First Aid station. And long-range goals include a plan to move the shelter into a newer building that will be more efficient to maintain.

As of January, ODM had several full-time staff openings, and volunteer opportunities exist regularly for serving meals at Our Father's Table.
