Sasha Tsutserov grew up in Communist Russia with his parents. His grandmother insisted he be baptized in the Orthodox Church and it was done in secret. As an adult, Sasha became a member of the Communist Party and worked for the KGB. He has a wife, Natasha and a daughter, Julia. His daughter, Julia, befriended a young girl whose father was a missionary in Moscow. As a KGB agent, Shasa felt obligated to investigate this family. He was awestruck by the humanitarian aid distributed by their church, and he was irresistibly drawn to their joy for life, for each other, and for the Lord. Then, while praying at a church retreat, he had a vision. From that moment on, he needed no evidence for God's existence, for he knew God in Jesus Christ. Sasha had never smiled before. But that day, Jesus made him smile. He admitted that he had become a Christian. Sasha now serves as director and professor at the seminary in Moscow, where they are raising up a new generation of Christian leaders.
