#### The Christmas Drive Thru Experience



In this season of generosity and care our Wesley Memorial tradition is to strongly support some of our local mission partners who serve the under resourced in our High Point community.


This year we have selected three mission partners that continue to do excellent work providing tangible help and sustaining hope for the individuals and families they serve.


#### **Membership Updates**
